WICKLIFFE, **OH**---Vanderbilt's Maria Bulanova and McKendree's Breanna Clemmer have been selected for top honors on the eve of the 2019 NCAA Championship as the National Tenpin Coaches Association unveiled its All-America team at the NCAA Awards Dinner Wednesday night.

Bulanova, the Division I Player of the Year, and Clemmer, the Division II/III Player of the Year, headed the five-woman first team that includes Nebraska's Raquel Orozco and Meghan Straub and Stephen F. Austin's Dakotah Hazlewood.

Bulanova was the Southland Bowling League Player of the Year after a season in which she won the Prairie View and Music City Classic tournaments and was named to five all-tournament teams. In leading her Vanderbilt team to the No. 1 seed at the NCAA Championship, she was second in the nation in overall average, Baker doubles and makeable spares.

Clemmer repeats as the D-II/III Player of the year and first team selection. The Bearcat anchor led the NCAA in Player Composite Performance, Baker average, filled frame, strikes and overall average. She had four top three finishes during the season.

Orozco is also a repeat selection on the first-team. The junior ranked among the nation's top five in several major categories including Player Composite Index and overall average. She had four Top 10 finishes.

Straub, a third-team honoree a year ago, had a banner senior campaign as Nebraska's anchor bowler. In addition to five Top 5 finishes including wins at the Bearcat Hammer and Track Kat Klash, she led the nation in traditional average (21.24) and Baker doubles (60.9) and ranked third in the Player Composite Index.

Hazelwood won the Kutztown Invitational and was second at the All-State Sugar Bowl as she earned All-America recognition for the first time. She ranked fourth nationally in overall and traditional average, sixth in the Player Composite Index and fifth in strikes, Baker average and first-ball 9 or strike.

The NTCA second team includes Taylor Bailey and Lauren Pate of McKendree, Emma Kuhn of Wisconsin-Whitewater, Bea Hernandez of Sam Houston State and Olivia Farwell of Duquesne.

The NTCA third team consists of Kaitlyn Eder of Louisiana Tech, Hope Gramly of McKendree, Adel Wahner and Samantha Gainor of Vanderbilt and Julia Huren of Arkansas State.

Sam Houston's Bea Hernandez was voted the Rookie of the Year in Division I after leading her team to the Southland Bowling League Tournament Championship while Hope Gramly of McKendree earned Rookie of the Year honors in Division II/III.

Vanderbilt's John Williamson was named the Division I Coach of the Year for the second time after guiding his team to a program record-tying five tournament championships while McKendree's Shannon O'Keefe repeated as Division II/III Coach of the Year after leading her team to three regular season titles and a repeat win at the Mid-America Intercollegiate.

The NCAA Championship begins Thursday morning at the RollHouse Wickliffe.
