### **All-American Bowling Teams Announced**

NASHVILLE, TN--- All-Americans Vicki Spratford of New Jersey City University, University of Nebraska's Amanda Burgoyne and Bryanna Caldwell of the University of Central Missouri headline college bowling's post-season honors recipients announced today by the National Ten Pin Coaches Association.

Burgoyne was voted the Division I "Player of the Year" after averaging 204.4 over 69 games. The senior was named to seven all-tournament teams out of the eight events she competed including the MVP award at the season's largest tournament the Morgan State Invitational. Caldwell, a junior, was named the year's Division II "Player of the Year" for the third straight season. She averaged 202.5 for 74 games in nine tournaments in which she made five all-tournament teams. Caldwell earned MVP honors at the Southern Varsity Invitational and Holiday Classic in Bessemer, AL. The Division III "Player of the Year", Vicki Spratford, garnered the most overall points of all the nominees. In the seven tournaments the junior competed, Spratford was MVP at the Jeanette Lee Invitational and named to four all-tournament teams. She ended the regular season with a win at the NECWBC Singles Championship and an overall average of 204.8 for 94 games. Burgoyne, Caldwell and Spratford were three of the five honored on the All-American first team. They were joined by Tina Peak from the University of Central Missouri and Becky Ketcham of Fairleigh Dickinson. Burgoyne and Caldwell are repeat first-team selections.

Nebraska redshirt freshman Cassie Leuthold won the Division I "Rookie of the Year" Award. Leuthold earned MVP honors in the Maverick Challenge and Greater Ozark Championship plus was named to all tournament teams in two other tournaments for the Huskers. It marks the second time in three years that a Nebraska player has this award. Jamie Mitchell of Central Missouri was awarded the Division II "Rookie of the Year". The Division III Co Rookies were Jenn Marmo of New Jersey and Tiffany Williams from the University of Wisconsin – Whitewater.

The NTCA All-America second team included Leuthold along with Erica Perez and Christi White of Fairleigh Dickinson, Josie Earnest of Vanderbilt and Adrienne Miller of Nebraska.

The All-America third team included Vanderbilt's Tara Kane, Marion Singleton of NCAA championship runner-up Maryland Eastern Shore, Lindsay Baker of Nebraska plus Kristi Kerr and Lindsay Frusciantie of Fairleigh Dickinson.

Ten women were named to the honorable mention list. They included Michelle Peloquin of Vanderbilt, Kristina Figueiredo of New Jersey City, Laura Zanruha of Maryland Eastern Shore, Whitney Smith of Alabama A&M, Alexandra Stein of St. Francis College, Chrissy Onderdonk of Sacred Heart, Lauren Banz of New Jersey City, Holly Churchill of Arkansas State, Karen Grygiel of Vanderbilt and Michelle Wallace from Maryland Eastern Shore.

Vanderbilt's John Williamson was voted Division I "Coach of the Year" after leading the Commodores to a 74-14 record and winning the school's first NCAA team championship in any sport during the program's third year of existence.

Ron Holmes of Central Missouri was the Division II "Coach of the Year" and Frank Parisi of New Jersey City was voted Division III "Coach of the Year" for the second straight year.

Voting was conducted by membership of the NTCA.
